

QUIZ: How water-wise are you?

My garden is zoned into 3 water-use zones: high, medium and low.

3 = Yes
2 = No zones but my plants are grouped according to water
0 = No
= My score

Part of my garden has been planted with local species, requiring no watering or irrigation.

3 = > 50%
2 = >25%
1 = >10%
0 = Not so
= My score

I have reduced my lawn to what my family uses daily.
